

NEW NCD DAC TRACKING CODES


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- Implemented in DAC members' 2019 reporting on 2018 ODA flows
- Divided into the following categories:
 - NCDs control, general
 - Tobacco use control
 - Control of harmful use of alcohol and drugs
 - Promotion of mental health and well-being
 - Other prevention and treatment of NCDs
 - Research for prevention and control of NCDs

The first data reported against these new codes will be available in December 2019.



GO recommends to go beyond "mobilizing" new resources (including through blending, risk sharing) and focuses on "maximizing" resources, in 3 ways:

- (1) Better articulating the various sources of Funds for Development for increased leverage and catalytic effects
- (2) Increasing the effectiveness and quality of financing flows ex. by promoting capacity building and transfers in pharmaceutical value chains
- (3) Better harnessing interlinkages and synergy of various financing sources
